2. **All Exhibition Building entry blanks** must list all items you wish to enter. Tags will be preprinted for each item. The entry form must be received by Sunday, August 4, 2019, in order for all items to be properly displayed.
3. **Late entries** will be accepted during the delivery hours, but there may be a wait in line at the time of delivery for them to be entered into the computer and for tags to be printed.
4. A tag will be preprinted for each article stating department, lot, and name of exhibitor and will remain attached to the article during the fair.
5. All exhibits must be delivered to the exhibition building on Thursday, August 8 between 3:00PM and 7:00PM OR on Friday, August 9 between 8:00AM and noon.
6. The Fair Committee will exercise all reasonable care of exhibits, but will not be responsible for any damage or loss that may occur.
7. In absence of competition, the awarding of premiums will be at the discretion of the judges.
8. All premiums will be paid according to records in the Judge's book.
9. Junior Division: 15 and under.
10. No exhibit fee will be charged but all exhibitors must purchase tickets to enter the fair during Fair hours. A season pass, good for all three days of the Fair, will be available for sale at the Exhibition Building during the delivery hours on Thursday and Friday.
11. Exhibits may not be removed before 6:00PM Sunday, August 11, 2018.
12. All exhibits must be picked up by 8:00PM on Sunday, August 11, or they will be disposed of at the convenience of the Fair Committee.
13. In making an entry, every exhibitor agrees to be governed by the rules and regulations herein.
