2. **All Exhibition Building** entry blanks must list all items you wish to enter. Tags will be preprinted for each item. The entry form must be received by Sunday, July 23, 2023, in order for all items to be properly displayed.
3. Late entries will be accepted during the delivery hours, but there may be a wait in line at the time of delivery for them to be entered into the computer and for tags to be printed.
4. A tag will be preprinted for each article stating department. Lot and name of exhibitor and will remain attached to the article during the fair.
5. All exhibits must be delivered to the exhibition building on Thursday, July 27<sup>th</sup>, between 3:00 and 7:00 p.m. **or** on Friday, July 28<sup>th</sup>, between 8:00 a.m. to noon.
6. The Fair Committee will exercise all reasonable care of exhibits, but will not be responsible for any damage or loss that may occur.
7. In absence of competition, the awarding of premiums will be at the discretion of the judges.
