GOAT SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis until all pens are full. **Youth Exhibitors ONLY.** Entries must be received by July 11.

2. All goats must comply with CT Department of Agriculture health requirements. All animals will be inspected prior to being off-loaded from vehicles. All goats must be listed on a health certificate signed by a veterinarian. A copy of this certificate is to be handed in at check-in.

3. No horned animals are allowed to be shown.

4. Judging will be at 9:00AM on Saturday. Judges' decisions are final. Breed lots may be combined to fill the class at organizer's discretion.

5. All entries must be on grounds by 3:00PM on Friday, July 25. All livestock EXCEPT Horses must enter and exit Gate 2 on the hill. Early delivery is available on Thursday, July 24 from 4:00PM-8:00PM

6. All exhibits must remain on the Fairgrounds until 5:00PM on Sunday. Exhibits shall be released in cooperation with Lebanon Lions Animal Superintendent. Leaving grounds early will forfeit premiums.

7. Show clothes are required to show animals (white shirt, khaki or white pants, closed toe shoes/boots).

8. Two three-day exhibitor passes will be issued to each exhibitor at check-in. Lost passes will not be replaced.
