General Show Info and Rules

The Lebanon Lions Club Horse Show will be held on July 26th, 9AM rain or shine at the Lebanon Country Fair Lower Pond Arena, 122 Mack Road, Lebanon, CT 06429. Show Manger, Rhea Distefano, showtimestables12@gmail.com, 203-213-9719.

- Regular classes \$10.00 Each. Barrels Jackpot & 2' Lebanon Fair Medal Classic \$20.00 each. Office fee of \$10.00 per back number. Post entry fee \$10.00 for entries received after pre-entry close date.
- Pre-entries MUST be postmarked by 7/22/26. Entries will be accepted after this date, including the morning of the show, but will be charged the \$10.00 post entry fee.
- Proper footwear and helmets are required for all riders regardless of age or discipline.

2026 Lebanon Lions Club Horse Show at the Lebanon Country Fair

- A copy of current Rabies and Coggins must be provided to the show office to receive a back number.
- Classes may be split or combined at the discretion of management. All decisions are final.
- Classes will be pinned 1st through 6th. Riders must participate in all 3 classes in a division to be eligible for day end Champion/Reserve.

Division Descriptions

Leadline – 1, 2, 3. Open to riders 10 years and under as of January 1st, 2026, who have never ridden independently at a show.

Beginner Walk/Trot/Jog – 4, 5, 6. Open to riders 18 years and under as of January 1st, 2026, who have never cantered at a show.

Open Walk/Trot/Jog - 7, 8, 9. Open to any age rider who have never cantered at a show.

Open Youth Junior – 10, 11, 12. Open to riders 13 years and under as of January 1st, 2026.

Open Youth Senior – 13, 14, 15. Open to riders 14-18 years of age as of January 1st, 2026.

Open Division – 16, 17, 18. Open to all Walk Trot Canter riders. Walk Trot riders cannot cross enter.

Green Horse – 19, 20, 21. Open to horses and ponies in their first two years of showing regardless of discipline.

Short Stirrup – 22, 23, 24. Open to riders 18 and under who have never competed higher than 18". Fences to be set at 18".

Open Crossrails – 25, 26, 27. Open to any age rider who has never competed higher than 18". Fences to be set at 18".

Open 2' Fences – 28, 29, 30. Open to any age rider. Crossrail riders cannot cross enter.

Pee Wee Gymkhana – 31, 32, 33. Open to Walk Trot riders of any age who have never cantered at a show. Canter strides will be penalized.

Youth Gymkhana, 34, 35, 36. Open to Walk Trot Canter riders 18 years and under as of January 1st, 2026. Walk Trot riders cannot cross enter.

Open Gymkhana, 37, 38, 39. Open to any age Walk Trot Canter rider. Walk Trot riders cannot cross enter.

2' Lebanon Fair Open Equitation Medal Classic - 30A. Open to Walk Trot Canter riders of any age. This will be a 2-part classic, with an over fences portion and the top 10 riders being called back for a flat phase. Top riders may need to perform a pattern.

Lebanon Fair Barrels Jackpot Classic - 39A. Open to Walk Trot Canter riders of any age. Top 3 placing riders will receive a payback.

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
